The Career Practitioners have reached many of their goals by; inviting students to book appointments, holding orientation session, ongoing credential checks, promoting other opportunities for credits, scholarship information, open houses, Discovery Days, hosting evening on-line sessions for parents, piloting information booths during parent teacher conferences and newsletters are sent to high school students and parents.  Services Collaborative team includes: the Director of Learning, the Inclusive Learning Coach/Early
 Learning Supervisor, the Clinical Team Lead, the LRSD Principal of Colony Schools & Pursuits and
 our Assistant Principals/Learning Support Teachers. Our Division accesses specialized services from
 Southwest Collaborative Support Services, our LRSD Speech Language Pathologist and KCC
 Behavior Support. Throughout the Division we have many students receiving supports with Severe

Disabilities, Mild-Mod Disabilities and/or Delays and English as an Additional Language. All of these student supports help achieve the LRSD vision of Every student, every day!
