

ORGANIZATION FOR INSTRUCTION

Background

The Principal is held accountable for the organization of the plan for instruction at the school level in accordance with the requirements of Alberta Education and Livingstone Range School Division.

Procedures

The Principal, in consultation with staff and other schools in the Division, when appropriate, shall develop a school plan which shall clearly outline the:

1. Organization of classes,
2. Organization of teacher and support staff assignments,
3. Course offerings of the school, including CTS,
4. The extra and co-curricular activities.

The Division recognizes that the function of assigning students to classes shall be the responsibility of the Principal, in consultation with all staff members affected at that division or instructional level.

It is further recognized that Principals have the flexibility to make choices about class composition based on a number of variables including student need, staffing, pedagogy, course offerings and the unique needs of the community.
