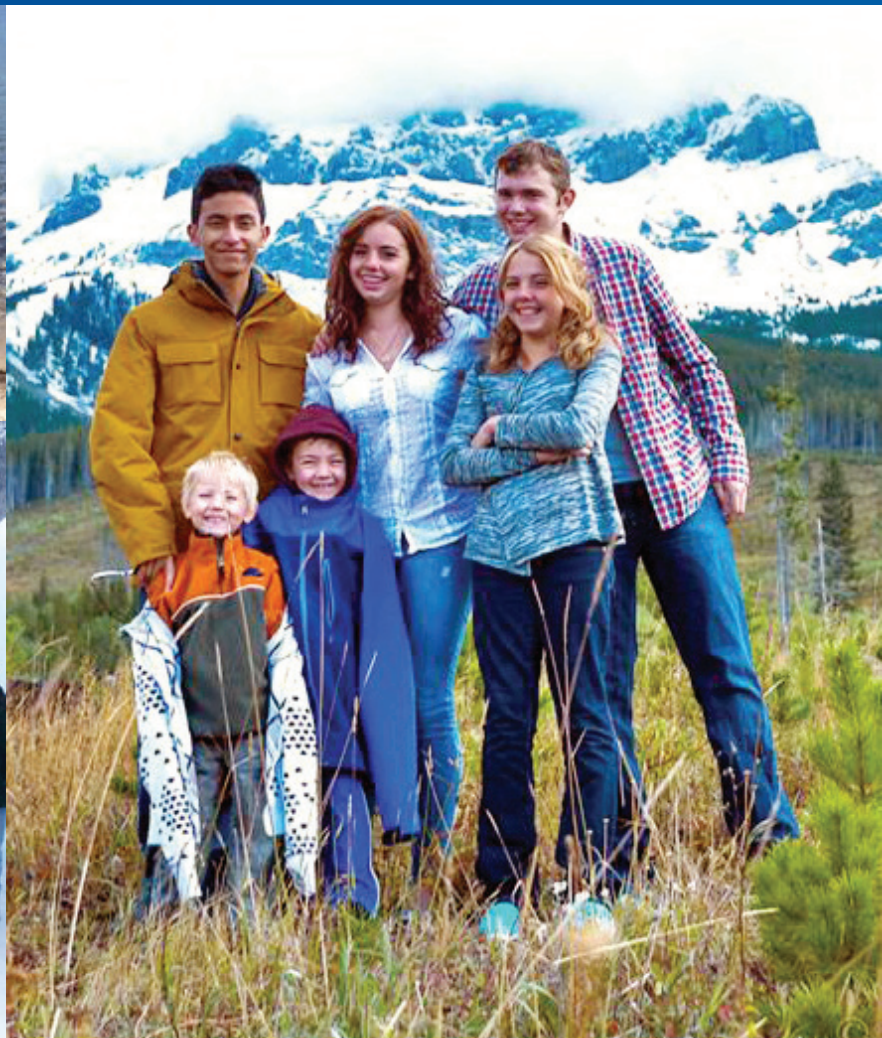




Opportunities
