

# Scenario 1

## In-school classes resume (near normal with health measures)

# School Re-Entry Plan

### General Building Safety

- Students & staff perform hand hygiene when entering/exiting school & classroom.
- Increased cleaning & disinfection of high-contact surfaces, washrooms, shared equipment.

### Screening

- Daily self-screening questionnaire.
- Parents/guardians play an integral role in the screening process for the student's daily involvement in school.
- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms must stay home.

### Cohorting

- A group of students & staff remain together as much as possible to limit potential exposure to others.
- Size of cohort depends on grade/class.

### Drop-Off/Pick-Up

- Staggered drop-off/pick-up times where feasible.
- Multiple drop-off locations.
- Wash hands or hand sanitize when arriving at school.

### Physical Distancing

- Physical distancing as much as possible to prevent spread of COVID-19.
- Student desks should be arranged so they are not facing each other.
- Emphasize hand hygiene & respiratory etiquette.
- Modified hallway traffic flow.
- Staggered start/end times for classes to avoid crowded hallways.
- Staggered lunch/recess.

### In-Person Learning

- Most classes will occur with modifications.
- Field trips involving buses are postponed.
- In-person singing, cheering, wind instrument activities are postponed.
- Provincial Achievement Tests (Gr 6&9) & Diploma exams will occur.

### At-Home Learning

- Parents who choose to not send their child to school can continue at-home learning.
- Child's teacher for at-home learning may not be from their regular school.



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### Visitors & Guests

- Minimal visitor & guest entry in school buildings; must follow school protocols & be arranged in advance.
- Upon entering, visitors & guests asked to complete self-screening tool.
- Non-school user group access limited.

### School Spaces

- Use of shared items/equipment avoided as much as possible.
- Gyms & libraries may be used.
- Some activities will be adjusted to meet COVID-19 requirements.

### Masks

- Mandatory for Grades 4-12 & staff; optional for K-Grade 3

### Responding to Illness

- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms should not enter the school.
- If a student develop symptoms at school: mask when possible, isolation, picked up.

### Transportation

- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms must not enter the bus.
- Students assigned seats.
- Increased cleaning & disinfecting of high-touch surfaces.
