



BOARD OF TRUSTESS KEY MESSAGES

Following are the Key Messages from the Board of Trustees Regular Meeting held on Tuesday, January 19, 2021.

- 1) **LRSD Fact Sheet on Reserves** – The Board of Trustees approved the LRSD Fact Sheet on Reserves based on the 2020 Audited Financial Statements. The LRSD Fact Sheet on Reserves is a document that summarizes the financial reserves held by the Livingstone Range School Division and identifies where they have been designated. LRSD reserves are reviewed on an annual basis after the completion of the Audited Financial Statements.
- 2) **International Education** - Chad Kuzyk, Associate Superintendent, Curriculum & Innovation presented an International Education update to the Board of Trustees. Due to COVID are international Student enrolment are substantially lower than normal. Government Protocols are strict but the amazing International Education team has been able to meet if not exceed the protocols/restrictions and have 19 enrolments for the 2020-21 school year. Upon their arrival all students will have to adhere to all quarantine and health guidelines.
- 3) **Inclusive Education** - Lisa Furukawa, Director of Learning (Support Services) presented to the Board on Inclusive Education throughout the division. The Director of Learning portfolio includes, but is not limited to, Learning Support, Early Learning, Behaviour Support, (FNMI) First Nation, Metis and Inuit, English Second Language, (SWCSS) South West Collaborative Support Services and Teacher Evaluations. Inclusion education aims to include all students with disabilities into our classrooms by emphasizing how these placements can be meaningful and purposeful. Why Inclusive education? - 4) **2021 Election – Shared Ballots** – The Board of Trustees approved the returning officer or designate requesting, where possible, shared ballots with Municipalities for the 2021 election.
